Student International Mobility Policy

1.0 Purpose

- 1.1 AUIB encourages international learning experiences that enhance students' academic development, global awareness, and intercultural understanding.
- 1.2 This policy establishes guidelines for student participation in international academic programs and mobility opportunities.

2.0 Scope

This policy applies to students participating in:

- exchange programs
- study abroad opportunities
- international internships
- international academic collaborations.

3.0 Policy

3.1 Students participating in international programs must comply with:

- university policies
- host institution regulations
- applicable visa and travel requirements.

Participation in international programs may require approval from the relevant academic department and university offices.

3.2 Student Responsibilities

Students participating in international programs must:

- maintain academic standing
- comply with program requirements
- represent the university responsibly while abroad.

3.3 Safety and Risk Management

Students must follow university travel guidelines and emergency procedures during international travel.
